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## 1SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITALS LO-2CATED IN A NONCONTIGUOUS STATE.

(a) INPATIENT CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL SERVICES.—Section 1814(l) of the Social Security Act (42
U.S.C. 1395f(l)) is amended by inserting "(or, in the case
of inpatient critical access hospital services furnished on
or after January 1, 2025, by a critical access hospital that
is located in a noncontiguous State, 105 percent)" after
"101 percent".

(b) OUTPATIENT CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL SERVICES.—Section 1834(g)(1) of the Social Security Act (42
U.S.C. 1395m(g)(1)) is amended by inserting "(or, in the
case of outpatient critical access hospital services furnished on or after January 1, 2025, by a critical access
hospital that is located in a noncontiguous State, 105 percent)" after "101 percent".

17 (c) AMBULANCE SERVICES.—Section 1834(1)(8) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m(l)(8)) is amend-18 19 ed by inserting "(or, in the case of ambulance services furnished on or after January 1, 2025, by a critical access 20 hospital that is located in a noncontiguous State or by an 21 22 entity that is owned and operated by a critical access hos-23 pital that is located in a noncontiguous State, 105 percent)" after "101 percent". 24

25 (d) SKILLED NURSING FACILITY SERVICES.—Sec26 tion 1883(a)(3) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.

1 1395tt(a)(3)) is amended by inserting "(or, in the case
 of covered skilled nursing facility services furnished on or
 after January 1, 2025, under an agreement under this
 section by a critical access hospital that is located in a
 noncontiguous State, 105 percent)" after "101 percent".
